

One Heart Questions, Sunday, June 27th, 20 10

This week's One Heart Discussion will explore the fact that we are more than conquerors through Christ. Our goal of becoming like Christ through letting the Spirit lead us is dependent on us understanding how God has given us everything we need to accomplish this goal. He has designed us in such a way that we need Him and His strength to lead us. Passages to study before your session are: Romans 8:28-37; 2 Cor. 4:7-10; 2 Cor. 12:7-10.

Discussion Questions...

1. Share with the group about one of the most embarrassing moments of your life. What happened?
2. As we get older, we learn how to laugh at ourselves. Why do you think we learn to do this?
3. Why do you think God made us so capable of making mistakes?

Please read Romans 8:35-37.

4. This passage tells us that we are more than conquerors through Christ. What are some things that you think we conquer through Christ?
5. Why is it essential to know that we are more than conquerors through Christ and not by ourselves?
6. This passage says that nothing can separate us from the love of Christ. What are some things that can make us FEEL separated from Christ?

Please read 2 Corinthians 4:7-10.

7. What are some ways that God designed us that make us Jars of Clay?
8. Look at the words Paul uses for the struggles they went through then. Name some ways that we as Christians today are hard pressed?...perplexed?...persecuted?
9. Paul says that they carried around the death of Jesus in their bodies. How do we do that today?

Please read 2 Cornithians 12:7-10

10. Why do you think God made us with weaknesses?
11. What are some ways that Christ's strength is seen through our weaknesses?
12. Why do you think Paul needed to know that God's grace was sufficient for him?
13. As we try to keep in step with the Spirit and become more like Christ each day, why do we need to know that God's grace is sufficient for us?
